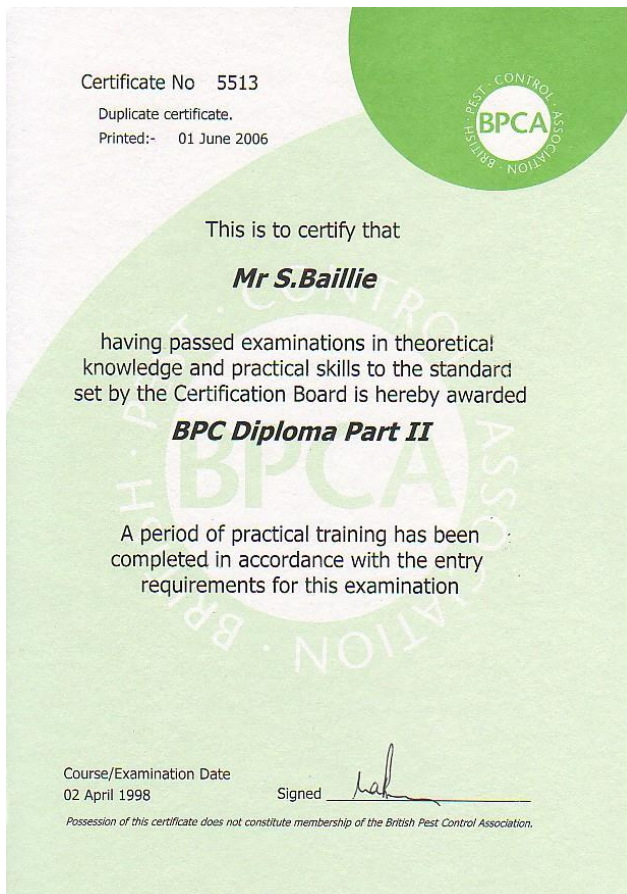
Background and career history

Scott is a Zoology graduate, and has worked within the pest control industry since the late 1980's. He started as a technician with Rentokil's Hull branch, and progressed through to Field Biologist, before moving to Igrox in the early 1990's.

Igrox is, today, one of the UK's largest pest control companies and Scott was instrumental, first as a technician, then as field biologist and ultimately as Northern Region Manager, in building their portfolio of high profile food industry customers from a very small initial base. He was responsible for a portfolio that included many large mills, bakeries and food warehousing facilities. Scott stayed with Igrox through that company's acquisition of the pest control business of Dynokil, and joined Acheta January 2006.
