



Environmental Policy

Introduction

Acheta Consulting Ltd specialises in the provision of pest control consultancy services to food and allied industries. Trained and competent personnel, working in accordance with relevant legislation and industry codes of practice, deliver this service.

We recognise that in our day-to-day operations we impact on the environment in a number of ways, and we wish to minimise the potentially harmful effects of such activity wherever and whenever possible. As a consequence of this, all our consultants are committed to constant consideration and review of their environmental performance and the minimisation of pollution.

Company functions and activities, which have been identified by management to be of environmental significance, are identified below, together with actions or policies that are considered to minimise the impact of these issues:

Transport

- Consultants work from home, so minimising business mileage with regard to workplace attendance.
- Consultants are not provided with company cars, as we believe that the use of personal vehicles, with reimbursement for company mileage, encourages more responsible driving practices and minimises mileage incurred on company business.
- Consultants are encouraged to purchase a fuel-efficient vehicle, such as a diesel or petrol-hybrid, as we believe that these offer the best environmental performance currently available to meet the needs of the Company and its customers.
- Car-sharing practices are encouraged whenever logistics allow.
- Public transport use is also encouraged whenever logistics allow.

Waste management

The only waste generated in Company activities is that from standard workplace office practices. Consultants are encouraged to recycle all non-confidential paper-based waste themselves. Confidential paper waste will be sent for commercial shredding and disposal thereafter. Items such as printer toner cartridges should be recycled as part of normal domestic recycling activities.
