Background and career history

Karen started with a degree in Biology with Education and Employment Studies from St Mary's University College, part of the University of Surrey. An area change saw her move to the Nottingham and Derby area taking over a number of pharmaceutical factories, supermarkets, warehouses and hospitals.

Eleven years on, and with a number of area changes, has seen her complete inspections in a wide variety of manufacturing processes. She was one of the first Field Biologists in Rentokil to take the RSPH Level 2 qualification in Pest Control followed by the BPC Diploma part II, the Level 3 Award in Food Safety Supervision for Manufacturing and the BPCA's Certificated Field Biologist qualification. 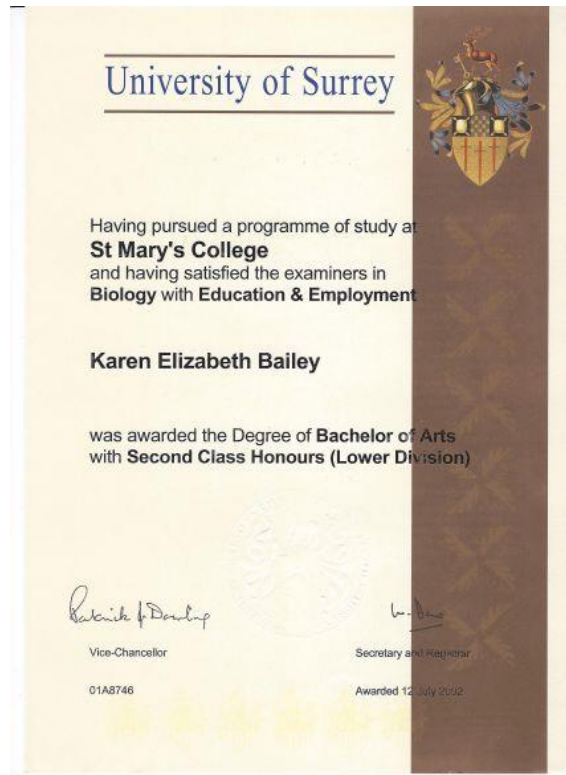
