

Pest awareness e-learning for the hospitality industry

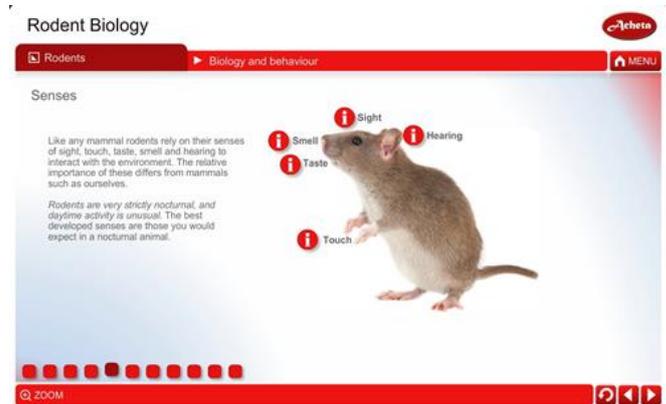
Essential Pest Awareness

Pest management is a pre-requisite for ensuring food safety wherever food is stored, prepared or eaten. Everyone working in such environments has a critical part to play in a successful pest management programme.

Designed particularly with food handling employees in mind, this entry level course, with an anticipated completion time of around 60-90 minutes, aims to impart the key facts concerning those pests that may present a threat in a food handling environment. The key topics are:

- Why controlling pests is important
- How they enter premises
- What they need to survive and multiply
- The basic principles of Integrated Pest Management
- Rodent and insect pest facts, including spotting signs of their presence
- The role of the individual in a successful IPM programme

An assessment comprising 15 questions, with a pass mark of 80%, allows verification that the essential knowledge has been acquired. A certificate is issued automatically when a pass is achieved. ***This course has been independently assessed by the CPD Certification Service; 1 learning hour.***



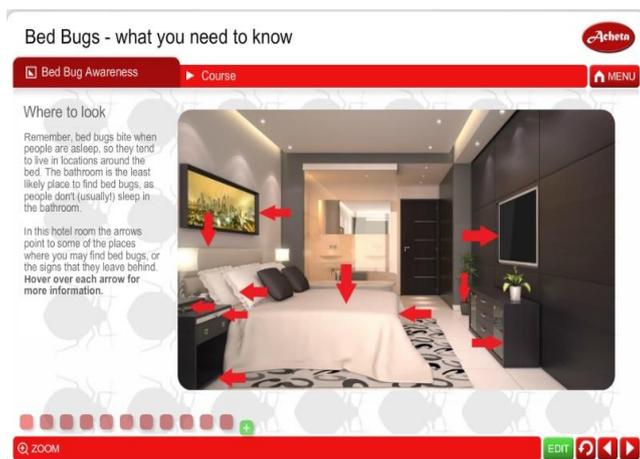

Bed bug awareness



Hotels are in the front line of the battle with bed bugs. Housekeeping staff, the eyes and ears of a hotel, are best placed to spot signs of infestation. They may also be in the front line when confronted by a guest who has been bitten. This short course, which takes around 45 minutes to complete, will provide your team with key knowledge concerning:

- Why bed bugs are a problem
- What they look like
- How they arrive
- Where to look for them, and what to look for
- What to do if they find them
- Getting a room ready for treatment
- How to handle an angry guest

Advanced Pest Awareness

For those responsible for managing the pest control contract, particularly in multi-site groups, the Advanced Pest Awareness course provides a more comprehensive level of technical training. The key objectives of this course are:

- To appreciate and understand the reasons why pest management in a food handling environment is of critical importance
- To review the principal rodent, insect and bird pests that may be encountered
- To understand those aspects of pest biology and behaviour that are critical to achieving successful control, and which can impact adversely on our ability to control them
- To be introduced to the principles and practices of a successful IPM programme.

This is a comprehensive course, with an estimated completion time of 6-8 hours. A 25-question assessment, with a pass mark of 70%, provides verification that the essential knowledge has been acquired. **A comprehensive course manual is issued as part of the course**, and a certificate is issued automatically when a pass is achieved.

This course has been independently assessed by the CPD Certification Service; 6 learning hours.
